*The Town of Richmond Hill is excited to have been chosen as a **Route Community** for the **Vancouver 2010 Olympic Torch Relay**. On Day 49 of the Relay, residents can celebrate the Olympic Spirit together as the **Olympic Flame** passes through our town on its way to Vancouver!*

The longest domestic Torch Relay in Olympic history will begin its Canadian journey on Friday, October 30, 2009. The Olympic Flame will travel by land, air and water during its 106-day journey as it visits more than 1,000 communities across Canada. More than 90 per cent of Canadians will be within an hour's drive and will be able to in the great moments of the 2010 Olympic Torch Relay.

The relay will culminate at BC Place on Friday, February 12, 2010, with the lighting of the Olympic Cauldron, signaling the start of the Vancouver 2010 Olympic Winter Games (February 12 - 28).

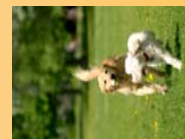
